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APHTHOUS ULCERS (CANKER SORES) MANAGEMENT

Aphthous is an autoimmune disease with poorly understood triggering causes. The lesions occur exclusively on unattached (cheek, floor of mouth, etc.) mucosa.

Prevention: Avoid triggering foods:

Nuts, chocolate, acidic fruits.

Avoid Trauma:

Toothbrush trauma, cheek bite, etc.

Avoid Sodium Lauryl Sulfate:

(A soap found in most toothpaste and mouth washes) Consider **Biotene** toothpaste or **Rembrandt for canker sore sufferers.**

Consider an Antimicrobial mouthrinse; Chlorhexidine or Prohealth..

Relief: Products which coat the lesion or numb it or both.

Examples: Orabase B Zilactin B Kanka

Liquid Carafate

Ora 5

Benadryl/Kaopectate

Aphthasol
